Making an SCA Trebuchet


Hudd De Peth; While siege engines like the catapult and the balista have been around since 800BC the trebuchet was first used by the French in the 12th century. Its ability to cast stones weighing over 300lbs made it immensely popular. With a range of over 400yds it could be placed well outside the range of the best bows and arrows where it could rain down death from above.

Stones were not the only ammunition used by the siegers, often dead cows and horses were sent over the walls into the besieged city or castle. The hungry populace ate the diseased corpses, and died themselves of food poisoning. They also sent the heads of their enemies

back over the wall into the city to demoralize the defenders. Even Heralds were not immune!

The last known use of a trebuchet in war was when Cortez attacked the Aztecs. He was running low on gunpowder when a man ran up to him and told him that he knew how to build a trebuchet. Cortez agreed to try it. Finally the trebuchet was

finished. They loaded it and set it off. The stone went straight up and came crashing down on the siege engine destroying it and the use of trebuchet in war for all time. I imagine it didn't do the Spanish engineer any good either.




Medieval artists concept of a Trebuchet

For SCA combat I decided that I needed to be able to throw 5 slit tennis balls, wrapped in duct tape, a distance of 30 to 50 yards, 20 to 30 yards being the furthest I've seen markland arrows travel. For the weight I used an I-beam weighing about 70 lbs and my throwing arm was 10 feet long.

The sling and the weight are what gives the trebuchet it's power. The sling on the end of the trebuchet makes it twice as powerful as a catapult of the same size. The sling should be 2/3rds the length of the arm when it's stretched out. You can change the arc of the missles by one of two methods. The first is changing the length of the sling. The shorter the sling is, the higher the arc becomes. A longer sling the lower the arc and the distance. One end of the sling is attached permanently near the end of the arm, and the other is attached by slipping the it over a pin sticking out the end. The second method is by changing the slant of the pin. This will help determine the arc of your missles by changing the release time of the sling. The pin should not stick straight up, but be slanted towards the target. This is

what happened to the unfortunate Spaniard. It is also helpful if you don't want to make new slings every time you want to change your target.


